Please use the table below to record when your child completes each activity by initialling in the correct box. Children who complete the 12 required activities for each separate subject will be rewarded with additional playtime. Therefore, they could be rewarded for reading, spelling and/ or maths. Please return the home learning on Monday 13th December.

Maths - Children should complete a maths activity on at least 4 occasions each week.

All children will be at different starting points so choose the appropriate one for your child's current understanding.

Maths Facts:

- Quickly recall all number bonds to 10, 20 and 100, and use these to give related subtraction facts.
- Keep practising your times tables. <https://www.timestables.co.uk/> is a great website. We have also played games in class using the site [Times Tables Games for 7 to 11 year olds \(topmarks.co.uk\)](https://www.topmarks.co.uk/times-tables-games). In Year 3 children should be working on 2-, 5-, 10-, 3-, 4-, 8- and 11- times tables. In Year 4, children should be aiming at knowing all the tables up to 12 x 12.
