

English:

We will spend the first two weeks learning how to construct a sentence, focussing upon word order, word class, grammar and punctuation. We will then move onto writing Letters, first person recount, diaries, posters, reports Setting and character descriptions, labels and postcards.

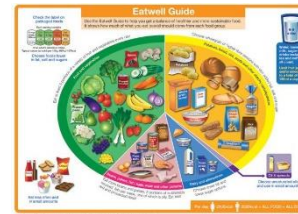
White Rose Maths:

The children will develop their knowledge of place value. They will use their learning from this to develop their addition and subtraction skills. This will cover the addition and subtraction of one and two digit amounts, and amounts of money. Reasoning and Problem Solving will take place every week, where the children will use strategies learnt to solve problems and explain their thinking.



Science: Animals Including Humans

The children will be able to describe animal and human life cycles. They will match the offspring to the adult. The children will learn what animals need in order to survive. They will learn about food and nutrient groups. They will learn how their body changes with regular exercise. Finally the children will learn why it is important to be hygienic.



Computing:

E-Safety: The children will learn how to stay safe whilst on-line at home and at school. They will learn the how to report worries and who to talk to.

Uses of IT

The children will discover how computers are big parts of our daily lives from the obvious to the more obscure.

PSHE: Me and My Relationships

The children will learn about the importance of the classroom as our learning environment; how to listen to each other; to identify different emotions and who they can talk to about them. They will identify their trusted adults.

RE: Sikhism

The children will learn about the Sikh holy book. They will find out about Sikh daily life. They will be able to describe the 5Ks and explain who the Khalsa are. They will find out what Vaisakhi is and what happens at Sikh weddings and naming ceremonies. They will also compare Sikh and Christian Creation stories.

Christianity

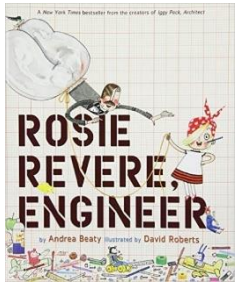

The children will learn to locate bodies of water around the UK and then around the world. They will then identify and research the different oceans including location, temperature, flora and fauna.

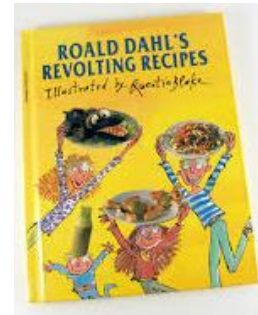


Art: Seascapes
